On the occasion of the 800th anniversary of foundation of Cittadella (1220), the Associations **CRUT**, **ART.AP**, **Steiner Waldorf Aurora School of Cittadella**, **Banca del Tempo del Cittadellese**, **Rotary Club Cittadella Alta Padovana** and **PassaParola Edizioni** in collaboration with **IAT** and **libreria Vettori** have organized the exhibition:

CITTADELLA AND VENETO IN DANTE'S *Comedy*

The exhibition, edited by Matteo Biscella and Stefania Carlesso, with the participation of Alessandro Anderloni, through the combination of elements of HISTORY, LITERATURE and THEATRE, has the purpose to excite and involve the visitor by introducing six Venetian characters mentioned in the *Divine Comedy*.

The characters, told from the point of view of Dante and from that of historical reconstruction, allow to identify some central issues of the *Comedy*.

Dante's interest towards human passions and their eternal relevance makes him a precious landmark for today's man, in constant search for answers to the great questions of life.

In this audioguided exhibition route, the narration merges with the performance of Dante's verses and with music, by combining history, literature and theatre together.
